- Child with Unilateral hearing levels
- Child with bone conduction hearing device
- Child with cochlear implant
- Child with hearing aid(s)
- Child who uses American Sign Language
- Child who uses Cued Speech
- Child who uses Listening and spoken language
- Child who is D/HH Plus



If so, we want to hear from YOU! The Maine Educational Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing is establishing an Advisory Council, composed of D/HH adults and parents of children who are D/HH. Members of this Advisory Council will be asked to share perspectives from their life experiences as the parent of a D/HH child or as a D/HH individual to inform the development of programs and resources for children who are deaf/hard of hearing and their families. We strongly believe in the principle of "Nothing about us without us," and want to ensure we incorporate this into our day-to-day work.

Responsibilities and compensation rates may include:

- \$100 initial 4-hour in-person meeting (Food, Overnight stay for anyone living over 90 miles from location)
- \$25 per review of short document review/discussion of specific topics (expectation of 1 hour)
- \$50 per review of longer project (i.e., video, multiple page resource) (expectation of over 1 hour)
- \$50 per meeting for development of a resource including 3 meetings (beginning, middle, and end of project)
- \$75 annual 3-hour in-person meeting (Food, Overnight stay for anyone living over 90 miles from location)
