Dear Parents/Caregivers/Teachers,

The state of Maine has passed [Kindergarten Readiness, Public Law Chapter 429](#) which requires ongoing assessment for all Deaf and hard of hearing children from birth to age six. Assessment information will be gathered by parents and staff to ensure that we have the most accurate picture of your child's development twice a year prior to review of your child's IFSP, or in the fall and spring. The results for individual children allow parents/caregivers and interventionists to monitor a child's progress over time and identify potential delays at their onset. Additionally, results from the assessment data can be used to generate IFSP outcomes and provide a data-driven approach to language and communication decisions as well as the supports needed to meet a family's desired outcomes.

The *Outcomes and Developmental Data Assistance Center for EHDI Programs (ODDACE)* assists providers by collecting and scoring all assessments and providing a comprehensive summary. ODDACE's aim is to support states in assessing Early Hearing Detection and Intervention (EHDI) outcomes, assisting states in using results to inform intervention, and creating a national outcomes database. The results from these assessments will help the state make programmatic decisions for D/HH children in Maine and will also help us to closely monitor your child's development to ensure they are making the language gains expected prior to Kindergarten. In addition, the results will assist intervention and educational programs in designing curricula that will maximize the success of all deaf and hard of hearing children. I will go over the following documents with you: a Demographic Form, the Developmental Assessment of Young Children (DAY-C), SKI-HI Language Development Scale, MacArthur Bates Communication Development Inventory (MB-CDI), Pragmatic Checklist, and any other supplemental assessments the team feels are pertinent to your child. Parents will receive an email from DocuSign for permission to share audiological information with the ODDACE team.
